He yearns to know more about these creatures, and in his quest for answers, he comes across a mystical craft that takes him down the abominable path of magic. He now learns more than he ever bargained for about these elusive creatures. And he also discovers terrible things he can do with his newfound powers. Alanna almost drowns at her father's marina.
