T'Challa, de laatste in een lijn van krijgerkoningen, is de Black Panther, begiftigd met buitengewone snelheid en kracht, en een pak dat is gemaakt van de onverwoestbare metaalsoort waarmee zijn land groot is geworden: Vibranium. Buitenstaanders zijn nu van plan om de rijkdommen van Wakanda te plunderen, inclusief de voorraad van het zeldzame metaal. Aan het hoofd van deze brute aanslag staat Klaw, een huurmoordenaar met het bloed van T'Challa's vader aan zijn handen. Klaw heeft een leger van superkrachtige huurlingen bij zich, allen vastbesloten om dood en verderf te zaaien in het ongerepte land.

Black Panther's troubles continue! The injuries that Ramonda suffered during the bombing worsen and her recovery is starting to seem like an impossibility. Plus, Shuri returns from Djalia... but is she herself? Or something more? Collecting Black Panther Vol. 6 #9-12 (subject to change).

Ta-Nehisi Coates op rassenpolitiek tijdens en na het Obama-tijdperk Van de allereerste zwarte president van de Verenigde Staten naar de verkiezing van de man die door Coates wordt omschreven als de 'eerste witte president' van Amerika, Donald Trump. Het contrast kon nauwelijks groter zijn. En toch is dit niet de eerste keer in de Amerikaanse geschiedenis dat er na acht jaar van hoopvolle vooruitgang ineens een drastische koerswijziging plaatsvond. 'We waren acht jaar aan de macht,' zo klonk de klaagzang van zwarte politici toen de witte overheersing terugkeerde in het zuiden van de VS na een periode tijdens de Reconstructie waarin er een einde leek te komen aan de rassenscheiding.
