Een Amerika dat zichzelf voorhoudt dat raciale tegenstellingen tot het verleden behoren, maar waar aanhoudende gewelddadige incidenten tegen de zwarte bevolkingsgroep een andere werkelijkheid laten zien. Coates maakt pijnlijk duidelijk hoezeer racisme in de Amerikaanse cultuur zit verankerd en dat gewelddadige uitpattingen geen toevallige incidenten zijn, maar voortkomen uit scheve machtsverhoudingen en diepgewortelde maatschappelijke noties. Hij kijkt vanuit een historisch perspectief en beschrijft hoe raciale gedachten door de eeuwen heen zijn geëvolueerd. Volgens Coates is racisme vooral een fysieke ervaring, waarbij de lijfelijke dreiging tegen 'black bodies' telkens een andere vorm aanneemt: van slavernij en opsluiting tot buitensporig politiegeweld.
